



## Takau Yoneyama :

Professor, Faculty of Business Administration, Tokyo Keizai University

Emeritus Professor at Hitotsubashi University

Takau Yoneyama retired Hitotsubashi University this spring, and to be Emeritus Professor. He moved to Tokyo Keizai University, where he takes a professorship on Business History. His research covers topics from Business History of Insurance to Enterprise Risk Management. He was a chair of the Study Group for Solvency Margin and the related regulations, FSA, and joined the Legislative Council on Insurance Law as a member. He was a president of the Asia-Pacific Risk and Insurance Association in 2012/13. He has been presidents of the Japan Society of Household Economics, and the Japanese Association of Risk, Insurance and Pensions. He was Chief Editor of Japanese Business History, and an editor-in-chief of JAVCERM Journal. He edited History of Insurance, 8 volumes (2000) with David Jenkins, and A Commentary on the Insurance Act in Japan (2010, in Japanese) with Tomonobu Yamashita. Recently, he edited Corporate Forms and Organizational Choice in International Insurance (2015) with Robin Pearson.
