Hideyuki is a Managing Executive Officer and Chief Actuary at Sumitomo Life Insurance Company, where he has been working for more than 30 years mainly in the area of Life Insurance.

Hideyuki graduated from Kyoto University. He subsequently completed a Master program at Kyoto University's Graduate School of Science (Master of Science), majoring in Mathematics. After that, he joined Sumitomo Life Insurance Company.

Hideyuki has played various roles at Sumitomo Life, mainly in the field of product development, profit analysis, budgeting and budgetary control, asset liability management and risk management.
