

Outline of OLIS 2026 Spring

1. OLICD Center

The Oriental Life Insurance Cultural Development Center, a public interest incorporated foundation, was founded in 1967 to support the development of life insurance in the Asian region. Since then, we have held seminars on life insurance for employees of life insurance companies and regulatory authorities in Asia. To date, more than 5,200 trainees have attended our seminars in Tokyo.

2. Schedule

OLIS 2026 Spring is to be held from Thursday, May 21, 2026, to Tuesday, May 26, 2026. Participants may check in at Kiyo Sakaguchi Learning Center (LC) on May 20 and check out on 27.

3. Venue

Kiyo Sakaguchi Learning Center (LC), Todoroki, Tokyo.

4. Theme

Life Insurance Business in Japan

5. Language

English is the official language of this seminar. All participants must have an adequate level of English proficiency, not only to understand lectures but also to actively participate in a Q&A session and a group discussion, or to give a presentation.

6. Number of Participants

The number of participants to be admitted is 40.

7. Qualification

Qualifiers are those who:

- 1) belong to regulatory authorities, life insurance companies or life insurance-related institutions.
- 2) have good communication skills in English.
- 3) are able to attend the entire program.
- 4) are healthy.
- 5) are recommended by their principal officer (President/CEO).

8. Application

The application shall be processed online at <https://www.olis.or.jp/e/index.html> **by March 2**. The following application materials shall be submitted to OLICD Center **by March 9** via email to olis-seminar@olis.or.jp or fax at +81.3.5501.6448; otherwise, the application is considered incomplete. **Incomplete, inaccurate, or late applications shall not be considered for the screening.**

- 1) Signed online application form with a photo
- 2) Résumé
- 3) Business card
- 4) A copy of passport (of the page(s) on applicant's personal data)

9. OLICD Center does not issue any required documents for a visa to enter Japan for those who are nationals of Indonesia, Hong Kong, Korea, Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, or Taiwan unless otherwise requested. Those participants are responsible for checking their eligibility for Visa Exemption if certain conditions apply.

10. Certificate of Completion

A certificate of completion signed by the president of OLICD Center shall be presented to participants who successfully complete the whole program.

11. Expenses

1) Round-trip flight

Participant's company/institution bears the cost of the round-trip flight.

2) Travel insurance

It is mandatory that participants' company/institution take out travel accident/sickness insurance.

3) Expenses for the stay in Japan

i. Accommodations

Participants stay at the lodging facilities adjacent to the LC, the venue of this seminar, free of charge during the seminar period, including Saturday and Sunday. No accompanying person is allowed to stay.

ii. Meals

Meals (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner) are provided at the LC dining hall on weekdays at no charge. The dining hall is closed on Saturdays and Sundays, so no meals are provided during the weekend. Please eat out or purchase meals on your own for the weekend. ¥2,000 in cash will be provided instead of dinner, only on a pre-request basis.

12. Screening

Screening shall take place in the week following the deadline. **The result shall be notified by March 20.** It is performed separately for applicants applying for TES (described below) and applicants not applying for TES. **Applicants not applying for TES shall take precedence.**

13. Travel Expenses Support Program (TES)

This support program is designed to cover the full or partial travel costs of OLIS seminar participants sent by companies/organizations facing budget difficulties. 14. Protection of Personal Information

Participant's name, company, job title, and email address shall be distributed among seminar participants.
